

Brissie Big Air 2021

Event Overview

Now in its 4th year the **Brissie Big Air** event is a highlight on the Queensland Kiteboarding calendar.

This annual event was established in 2018 as an initiative of the local Redcliffe Kiteboarding Community. The Big Air aspect of Kiteboarding is close to the heart of every kiteboarder.

The event brings together the entire community to enjoy the spectacular, high energy & gravity defying antics of the Big Air Kite crew.

Queens Beach North has been the spiritual home of Kiteboarding on the Redcliffe Peninsula for many years now. With its natural amphitheatre beach shape, seating and viewing of the event is excellent from any angle.

In 2021 the fleet will consist of 30 riders. Competitors entry is on a first in - first served basis. The **Brissie Big Air** caters for all levels of riders, whilst the aim of the event is to boost the biggest jump they can, the real gold in this event is getting the riders together to showcase kiteboarding to the local community.

As the event is wind dependent there will be a holding period of 1 month. November is traditionally windy allowing us to put aside 4 weekends. To run the **Brissie Big Air** event, we require a minimum of 20 knots forecast before we will call the event on.

We keep a constant dialogue going with the public/riders & sponsors during the holding period.

Event Goals

- 1. To host an exciting high energy event that the public can enjoy.
- 2. Highlighting the water sports community that has called the Queens Beach North home for nearly 30 years.
- 3. To host an event that pushes the competitors to reach beyond their limits and impress the crowd.
- 4. To create an inclusive event for kiters of all levels.
- 5. To bring the community together to celebrate all things kitesurfing

The Nuts & Bolts of it

Riders will be sent out to compete in 8 minute heats, each rider will have two heats to produce their biggest jumps. From these heats each rider's two best jumps will be averaged, allowing us to create semi finals, quarter finals etc. The final four riders compete for a further 15 minutes, using the results from WOO devices we then crown our **Brissie Big Air** Champion.

For the past three events we have used and loved WOO devices - how does it work?

The WOO detects jumps by tracking and analyzing your motion. To do this, it fuses data from the 9-axis motion sensor to understand orientation in space and the accelerations acting on it. It is able to categorize your riding into distinct phases of motion: inactivity, riding, jumping, landing or crashing and so forth. If you need to know more follow this <u>link</u>.
